

Late Assignments

There is great variety in the demands of each academic area, and consequently there is great variety in teachers' systems of grading and evaluation. Late assignments will not be given full credit, and how much credit is given will be contingent upon the discretion and academic evaluation system of the teacher involved. In the case of excused absences, students will be given as many days as they were absent to make up their missed work. However, this make-up period may not exceed the end of the semester when final grades are due. Students will lose participation credit for any unexcused absence, for class sessions cannot be made up. Also, when an absence is unexcused, partial or no credit may be given for work missed. When students are absent, it is their responsibility to contact their teachers either in person or by email in order to stay on top of their lessons and all associated work.

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
