Academic Failure Due to Absenteeism

Upon the fifth and tenth student absence in a semester, excused or unexcused, the student's parents will be notified of the absences, along with a copy of LCS's absence policy. At this point, the students' parents/guardians may be contacted and asked to attend a conference concerning the academic progress of their student. During the conference, all parties will take part in an investigation into the causes and consequences of the absenteeism, and a plan will be put in place for the student's attendance and academic progress. The student may fail classes in which they have missed ten or more days due to the nature of class time at LCS, the required seat hours, and the course content and discussions that have been missed.
